When I see the children suffering in Haiti, I am stimulated to try to help in some way. Our church will be collecting the following items to help the injured and the thousands of very young children in this time of tragedy.

If you can help us, please bring any of these items to Christ Church no later than Sunday January 31, at 1:00 p.m.:

- Antibiotic ointment such as Neosporin and other brands
- Bandages
- Rolled gauze
- White medical tape
- Ace bandages
- Hydrogen peroxide
- Alcohol pads
- Iodine (wipes/bottles)
- Cotton swabs
- Cotton balls
- Masks
- Latex and non-latex gloves
- Infant formula -- powdered preferred. Must not be opened or expired
- Nutritional supplements such as Ensure and Pedialyte
- Diapers

When I see the sorrow and suffering in Haiti I understand from a new perspective why it is more blessed to give than to receive. God bless you for your generosity.
