Items can be dropped off at Christ Church throughout the week. Deadline is Sunday, January 31 at 1:30 p.m.

- Antibiotic ointment such as Neosporin and other brands
- Bandages
- Rolled gauze
- White medical tape
- Ace bandages
- Hydrogen peroxide
- Alcohol pads
- Iodine (wipes/bottles)
- Cotton swabs
- Cotton balls
- Masks
- Latex and non-latex gloves
- Infant formula -- powdered preferred. Must not be opened or expired
- Nutritional supplements such as Ensure and Pedialyte
- Diapers
